TELFA made by the company Tele-Industrie N.V. at Florastraat 12 in De Pinte near Ghent. The offices were at the address Wilgenstraat 3, a manor house called Les Conifères. The company produced radio and television sets, and also coin-operated radio-gramophones in the early 1950s, and it was considered to be an independent affiliation of the major Barco radio company in Kortrijk.
